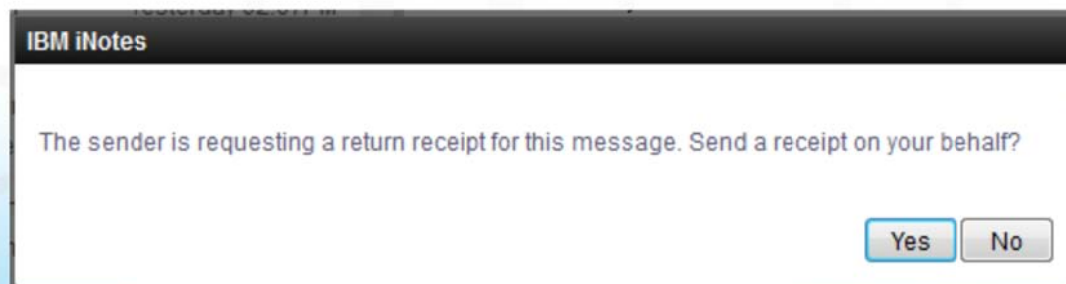
More Consumability Improvements

- Paste clipboard images into rich text editor area
 - Firefox® and Chrome™ today. Expecting Safari® to work with next major version.
 - Not possible with Internet Explorer® 10.
 - Images (smaller ones) may now be pasted within HTML signature field as well
- Insert PNG images
 - in addition to JPEG and GIF
- Drag and drop files from operating system into attachments area (Firefox, Chrome and Safari)
- Import CSV contacts
- Save draft message (and keep editing)
- Asynchronous retrieval of unread message content (faster message opens)
- Move folder to a new location in folder hierarchy

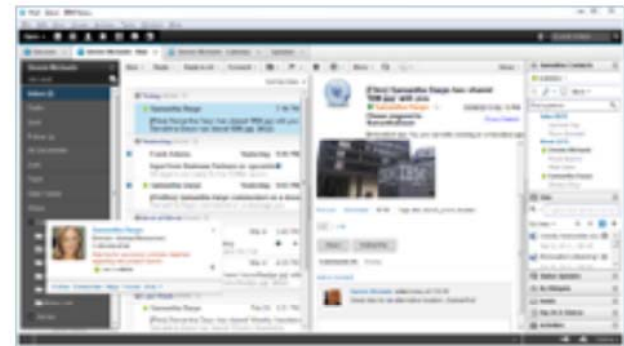

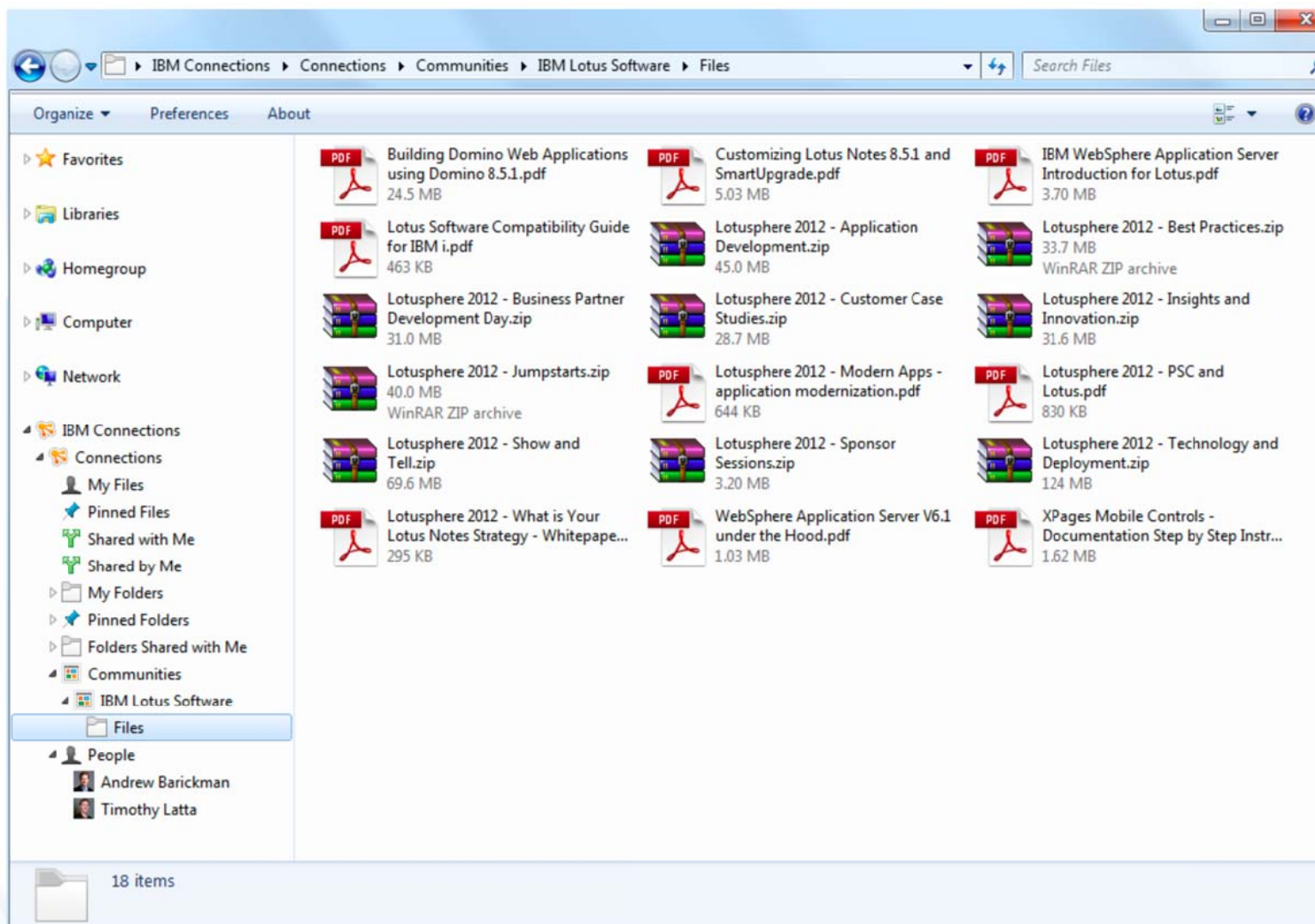
